Students interested in apply to a four-year college/university should speak with a counselor to review eligibility requirements. Please see below for basic requirements:

1.) A-G Requirements: California State University/University of California

- A- History/Social Science: 2 years required
- B- English: 4 years required
- C- Mathematics: 3 years required, 3 years recommended for UC
- D- Lab Science: 2 years required, 3 years recommended for UC
- E- Foreign Language: 2 years required, 3 years recommended for UC
- F- Visual & Performing Arts: 1 year required
- G- College Preparatory Electives: 1 year required

2.) Grade Point Average:

CSU- Minimum GPA of 2.0 or higher in all A-G classes

UC- Minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher in all A-G classes
